## On Call Environmental Services RFQ No. 23-021

 (Page 67; Exhibit C. General Terms and Conditions; #5 Indemnification) and (Page 71; Exhibit D. Special Terms and Conditions; #2 Indemnification) It seems there are 2 different indemnity provisions between Exhibit C and Exhibit D. Can you confirm which one takes precedence?

22<sup>nd</sup> DAA Response: Order of precedence is Exhibit C, then Exhibit D

- 2. (Page 65; EXHIBIT A SCOPE OF WORK; S. GIS Mapping/Graphics preparation/Survey) Are you expecting a registered engineer to do the GIS work? (As-built documents, etc.)
  - 22<sup>nd</sup> DAA Response: No. This section simply requires that GIS capabilities be included within the submitted proposal. As-built documents will not be needed as part of this contract.
- 3. (Page 40 of the RFP PDF; page 3 of the standard form 330) Regarding the Federal Form 330 requested, do you want to see 10 sample projects in section F. EXAMPLE PROJECTS WHICH BEST ILLUSTRATE PROPOSED TEAM'S QUALIFICATIONS FOR THIS CONTRACT, or will the four (4) projects (requested in the Qualifications section on page 8, section c. Quality and relevance of recently completed or ongoing work), in addition to any relevant subconsultant projects, be sufficient? The "4 projects" is referenced from section: c. Quality and relevance of recently completed or ongoing work:
  - "Provide two (2) examples of work products that illustrate the nature and scope of CEQA projects completed by the firm within the past five (5) years that cover Master or Specific Plans.
  - Provide two (2) examples of projects completed within the past five (5) years that demonstrate expertise in preparing CEQA documents. If no completed projects are available, please provide examples of ongoing projects."

22<sup>nd</sup> DAA Response: Please provide 4 projects as identified in the Statement of Qualifications section.

- 4. (Bid Submittal Checklist; page 3; #5) Do you want to see all Federal Forms 330 for each subconsultant, even if they are not "Key"? If so, are they required to complete all 330 forms each separately, or should they be added to our filled out 330 forms?
  - 22<sup>nd</sup> DAA Response: Only key subconsultants need to be included, and they can be included in the primary firm's 330 form.
